**FAVORITE OFF-STRIP GETAWAY:** "Mount Charleston—you can ski in the winter and they have great hiking trails for the summer."

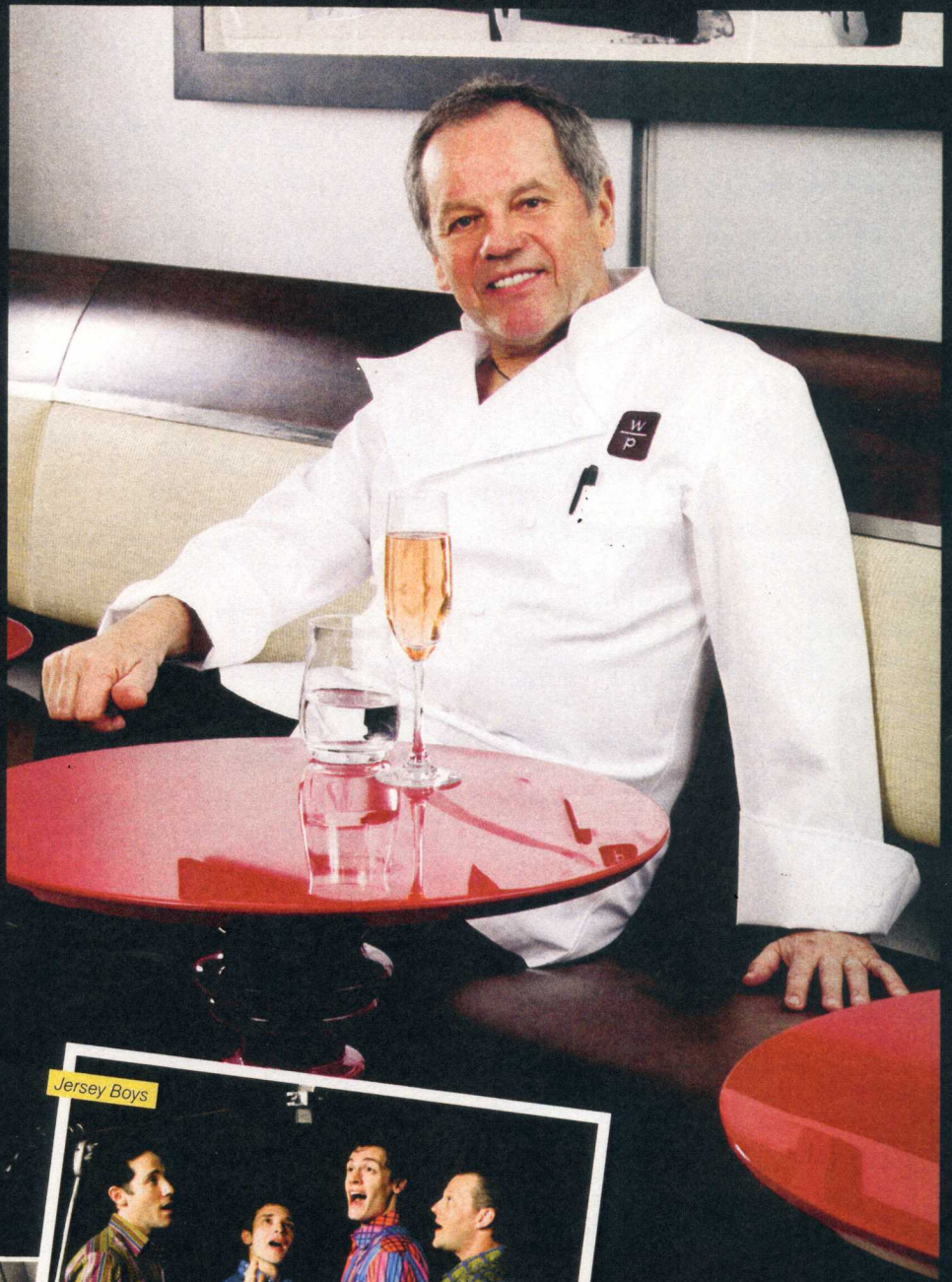
**FAVORITE LOCAL PERSON TO HOST/**
